The Board authorizes the use of video surveillance equipment on school district property as necessary to enhance the health, safety and security in our school district.

The Board recognizes that privacy is a critical value in a democratic society and emphasizes that this video surveillance policy, and the practical use of video surveillance, must be guided by a commitment to the privacy and safety of staff, students, volunteers and the
